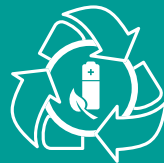


Spring Cleaning While Staying Home? Don't Trash Your Batteries!

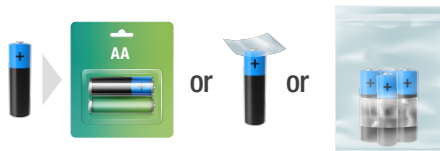
