

AGREEMENT WITH CALL2RECYCLE REGARDING THE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING OF HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES

The Company identified below (hereinafter referred to as "you" or "Obligated Steward") is responsible for collecting and recycling used consumer batteries under one or more Provincial statutes or regulations and wishes to have the Call2Recycle Canada, Inc. ("CALL2RECYCLE") facilitate its compliance with its obligations as to used consumer batteries.

I. DEFINITION. As used herein, the term "COVERED SALES" means the total weight in kilograms of consumer-type primary (single use) batteries weighing less than five (5) kilograms sold into any Province listed in the Appendix to this Agreement (whether sold independently as batteries or as batteries contained in products).

II. YOUR OBLIGATIONS. You agree to do the following:

- 1. Transmit to CALL2RECYCLE a completed and signed copy of this Agreement along with a listing of all battery brands that fall under this Agreement.
- 2. By the 30th day following every calendar quarter after this Agreement is signed by Obligated Steward, send to CALL2RECYCLE the following:
 - (a) A check equal to its actual sales (kg's) into the Provinces listed in the Appendix to this Agreement during the quarter just ended multiplied by the per kilogram fee set by CALL2RECYCLE. As of January 1, 2012, the aforementioned per kilogram fee is C\$ 0.80 for COVERED SALES into British Columbia, Manitoba, and Quebec. CALL2RECYCLE may adjust this fee with one hundred eighty (180) days' notice to Obligated Steward.
 - (b) An accurate report of your total COVERED SALES during the calendar quarter that ended three months before using the reporting form provided by CALL2RECYCLE.
- 4. Promptly respond to any written communication from CALL2RECYCLE regarding reports or payments to CALL2RECYCLE.
- 5. Provide CALL2RECYCLE with a copy of any sales information that you are required to report to the government-related agency(ies) supervising battery recycling simultaneous with the submission of such information to the government-related agency(ies).



III. CALL2RECYCLE'S OBLIGATIONS. CALL2RECYCLE agrees to do the following:

- 1. Operate the consumer battery program(s) pursuant and consistent with provincial programs as listed in this document and amended from time to time for specific provincial or program changes including incremental provinces.
- 2. All material changes will be communicated to the Call2Recycle within 90 days. All approved provincial programs and related information are listed on our web site and CALL2RECYCLE will undertake to keep this current.
- 3. After receipt of your completed and signed agreement, we will provide you with reporting forms and information pertinent to future payments and reports.
- 4. Maintain as confidential any company-specific sales information provided to CALL2RECYCLE pursuant to Section II above.

IV. ADDITIONAL TERMS.

Nothing in this Agreement supersedes the requirements that certain Provinces (e.g., Ontario) have placed on Obligated Stewards to conform to regulations including providing information to a government-related agency(ies).

BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, I CERTIFY THAT I AM AUTHORIZED TO BIND THE ENTITY ON BEHALF OF WHICH I AM SIGNING AND HAVE REVIEWED AND ACCEPT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.
