

BULK SHIPPING BATTERIES IS EASY USING THESE 7 STEPS

BULK SHIPPING GUIDELINES

1 500 lbs. or More

Check that you have a MINIMUM of 500 lbs. total for your shipment.



2 Dry-Cell Only

We accept:

- Rechargeable: Ni-CD, Ni-Zn, SSLA/Pb, Ni-MH or Li-Ion
- Single-use*: AA, AAA, 9V, C, D, button or lithium primary

Each battery must weigh less than 11 lbs.

**Check if single-use are accepted at your collection site.*



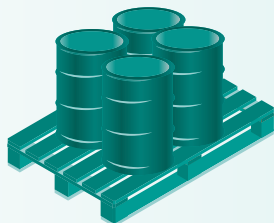
3 Tape or Bag It

Battery terminals that touch metal can cause a spark or fire. We recommend each battery be bagged or the positive terminal taped. Use Call2Recycle bags, clear bags or non-conductive tape.

4 Place On Pallets

Approved bulk shipping containers must be placed and secured to pallet(s).



5 Bill Of Lading

Your shipment will need a Bill of Lading (BOL). Login to the BOL Wizard using your Call2Recycle site ID and 5-digit zip code. Contact Customer Service at 877-723-1297 for a site ID.



6 Label the Shipment

The BOL Wizard will create the shipping labels. Place one label on each container and mark the pallet accordingly. Attach one copy of the BOL to each pallet.



7 Schedule Pick Up

Schedule your pallet pick up through the online BOL Wizard.



Special Instructions

- Batteries must be shipped in a UN-rated steel drum (1A) with plastic liner or a UN-rated polyethylene drum (1H). Drums must have an open head and lever lock ring. Please contact Call2Recycle Customer Service about the use of other containers.
- Containers with Lithium-Ion batteries that have a gross weight of more than 66 lbs. must be shipped as fully regulated hazardous material using a BOL.
- Shippers must be hazardous material certified per U.S. DOT regulations.
- Call2Recycle recommends you bag or tape all batteries. For proper procedures and minimum requirements, visit www.Call2Recycle.org/safety.
- Damaged, defective or recalled Li-Ion batteries require special U.S. DOT-approved handling. Contact Customer Service at 877-723-1297 for help. Do not place in your regular shipment.
